Behavior Cost Estimate

When you set your appointment, you will receive an estimate of the initial exam fee. The need for additional testing and treatments may not be known prior to examination, so it may not be possible to give an estimate all of the costs in advance. Once the behaviorist examines your pet, you will receive an assessment of your pet's options, plans and an estimated cost.

Payment Policy

Please share all of your questions and concerns regarding treatment costs with your behaviorist or a front desk coordinator prior to the sessions.

Payment is required at the time services are provided. Cash, check, debit card, MasterCard, Visa, Discover Card, and Care Credit (third party billing) are accepted forms of payment.

Preparing for your Behavior Consultation

Please bring the following to your appointment:

- Bring a copy of your pets' most current vaccines, bloodwork, radiographs and diagnostic test results with you to your appointment.
- Bring a list of any current and all medications (name, dose, and schedule) your pet is taking.
- Please arrive 15 minutes early to complete registration forms.
- Please have your pet controlled on a leash or in a carrier.

During your pet's consultation the behaviorist will perform a physical exam, obtain a complete medical history, and evaluate your pet's condition. After the examination the behaviorist will then discuss your pet's behavioural needs, and together you will agree to a treatment plan.
